- ~ Collaboration with the Rec League to plan fun and exciting events that cater to all ages. I would love to see residents get involved with events they are passionate about and volunteer to make these come to fruition.
- ~ Lastly would be communication to the residents. To make information more easily accessible to all. I find our website not very user-friendly. One example of this would be if you wanted to look at the minutes from a council meeting. To see the agenda, minutes, and reports for one meeting you need to go to numerous links. One to find the agenda, another to go to the minutes, a third to read the Mayor's report, fourth to read the Deputy Mayor's report etc. I would love to see this site more efficient. It's hard to find information on our page. Other ideas include a bulletin board where residents have access to read what is happening in Sandy Beach and a newsletter that is not just electronic. I feel that this is a very important issue that needs to be addressed.

I love living out here. I feel at peace when I wake up and go to bed here. I look forward to speaking to residents and hearing their input. I am excited to learn, and I feel that we all need a voice and a chance to look into how we together can make our community a place where people want to visit and live. I do not want our beautiful community to become stagnant. I have met many residents that are willing to volunteer their time to make our home the best that it can be.
