## 17 MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC WERE IN ATTENDANCE

- 1. Mayor Denise Lambert called the Annual Information meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.
- 2. Mayor Denise Lambert introduced Deputy Mayors and Administration. Mayor Denise Lambert welcomed everyone to the meeting. Mayor Lambert informed the public of the staff working in the office; Lana Lange and Susan Dales and the CAO is Wendy Wildman, Public Works is Gerry Taylor and Neil Barnett. Mayor Denise Lambert reviewed the Rules of Decorum for members of the public in attendance.
- 3. Mayor Denise Lambert reported this council has a very critical view of what they put dollars toward. From the 2015 Budget Council has Municipal Services Package (MSP), Library Services, East End Bus and Physician Recruitment. In the future Council will have to deal with speed bumps on the newly paved road, unsightlies, fire mitigation, brushing, Intra Municipal meetings with Summer Village of Sunrise Beach and Alexander (note that today is the 139th anniversary of the signing of Treaty 6) and we have to be aware of how this Government will look at this.

Deputy Mayor John Hellings reported he felt the Summer Village is looking good with the beautiful flowers, the grass cutting and new grass on the boulevards. Taxes have not been increased and Council looked at what was needed and what was not needed. The summer Village is not like Spruce Grove and Stony Plain because they can expand to get more tax dollars but we cannot.

Deputy Mayor Audie Bigelow reported that Council is happy with how things are looking but there is always room to improve.

- 4. Informal discussion topics with residents included fire and causes of the past fires, what are the steps to install a residential cistern, speeding especially on the new pavement on Lakeshore drive, Community Peace Officer services, loud noises fireworks, loud parties, Land Use By-law, speeding, ATV's, Wild Water project and accolades to the public works for their work.
