BY-LAW 84

Is a By-Law of the Summer Village of Sandy Beach to prevent the filling or plugging or causing damage in any way to the drainage ditches within the boundaries of the Village.

Section "A"

The installation of a driveway must be constructed so as not to impede the flow of water through the ditches. A culvert 10" x 20' must be installed with the bottom surface below the level of the ditch. The culvert must be of a style and kind approved by the Village council and the installation must also meet with their approval.

Section "8"

The ditches must not be increased or reduced or in any way modified without obtaining the express permission of the Village council.

Section "C"

Any person who commits a breach of this by-law may be issued an offense tag by a Peace Officer. The sum payable shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00).
