

BYLAW # 199-1995

A BYLAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF SANDY BEACH IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ESTABLISH A DEVELOPMENT APPEAL BOARD.


WHEREAS the council of the Summer Village of Sandy Beach, in the Province of Alberta, pursuant to the provisions of the Planning Act, being Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980, Chapter P-9 with amendments in force as of June 15, 1991 and including any future amendments, (Sections 33-35) deems it expedient to provide a bylaw for the purpose of establishing a Development Appeal Board.

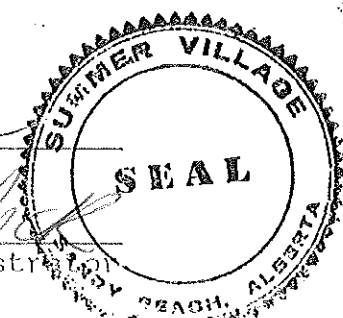
NOW THEREFORE the council of the Summer Village of Sandy Beach, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That this Bylaw shall be known as the "Development Appeal Board Bylaw".
2. That the Summer Village of Sandy Beach shall establish a Development Appeal Board made up of current council members and have the discretion to appoint a Development Appeal Board where council feels it is in the best interest of the Summer Village.
3. That this bylaw shall come into effect upon being given third reading.

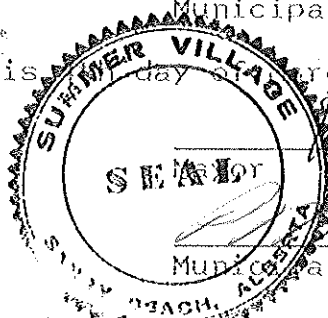


