Snow Plowing Policy

Intent

The Summer Village of Sandy Beach has adopted this Policy to ensure the ongoing safety of our employees and to provide safe roads within the Summer Village.

Scope

The Snow Plowing Policy applies to all employees of the Summer Village of Sandy Beach who are responsible for maintaining and clearing the roads due to snow fall.

General Guidelines

Employees are expected to maintain and clear the roads of the Summer Village of Sandy Beach, this includes Lakeview Drive, Blue Herron Drive, West Cove Drive. Lakeshore Drive or Highway 642 is the responsibility of Alberta Highways

- 1. Once a snow fall is approximately **8 cm**, and the snow has stopped falling, then the public works foreman is expected to plow out the entire Summer Village.
- 2. If the public works foreman is not available then the alternative driver is to be called by the foreman or administration.
- 3. The administration will call the foreman if the roads are needed to be cleared, when he is not in the Summer Village.
- 4. After the end of a major snow fall, opening the roads will take approximately 1 day.
