Oct 7 2020 meeting with LSA County council, Sunrise, and Sandy Beach

The county asked us as a delegation to discuss the situation of large amounts of water being held back at Dushane and Anderson Lakes, and a large amount of water accumulating in fields west of RR12a near Sunrise Beach. This water would normally flow into Sandy Lake.

Several causes were discussed, those being culverts plugged and or at improper depths, natural drainage channels that have being filled or damaged and beaver dams.

It was moved by LSA County Council, that they would do repair or replacement work on any culverts or roadways as per general maintenance. This would include opening up beaver dams situated on county property where assessable.

Send a letter of complaint to environment about unauthorized hold back of water.

Get a quote from Environmental firm for a drainage study. This will be reviewed by all three parties in regards to a cost share.

Open up Beaver dams on private property with permission of owners.

Sunrise and Sandy to send joint letter to Alexander in regards to Beaver Dams or traping.
