NOTICE OF SENATE ELECTION AND REFERENDUM QUESTIONS VOTING

In reference to the above noted, please be advised that under the provisions of the Alberta Senate Election Act and the Referendum Act the Summer Village of Sandy Beach is hereby providing the prescribed Notice of Election.

Operating slightly differently than the municipal election held earlier this year, the Senate and Referendum Vote is being conducted in coordination with the Town of Onoway (our designated municipal partner for the purpose of this election) and is open for participation by eligible electors residing in the summer village. This means that voting will occur on the same day as Alberta's general municipal elections and it means that you may only vote if you are a <u>resident</u> of the summer village. For clarity, all eligible electors must vote in the location where they designate their residency, and each elector may only vote once throughout the province in this election.
