## Re: Notice - Immediate Water Restrictions - WILD Water System

In reference to the above, please be advised that a line break has occurred and is now in the process of being repaired. As a precaution, the WILD Water Commission has issued an immediate mandatory water restriction on the impacted section of the system, effective immediately, until further notice.

The following service areas are included in this restriction order:

Heather Down Truck Fill (Off-Line)
Kapasiwin Truck Fill (Off-Line
Seba Beach Truck Fill (Off-Line)
Sandy Beach Truck Fill (Off-Line)
Alberta Beach Truck Fill (Off-Line)

Paul First Nation (Mandatory Water Restriction)
Alexis Nakota Sioux Nation (Mandatory Water Restriction)
Town of Onoway (Mandatory Water Restriction)
Parkland County (Wabamun) (Mandatory Water Restriction)

All other service areas are advised to be on alert should this order need to be expanded as the situation develops. Also, we are evaluating the necessity for a boiled water advisory; although not required at this time, depending on the extent of the repair required it may become necessary for a boiled water order to be added to these restrictions and we will update stakeholders if same becomes necessary.

Please share this notice with your communities. For those members with direct connections, please share this update with your operations staff and consider implementing restrictions within your communities so as to conserve your existing individual reservoir capacities.

WILD is currently working to get the system back to full operation. However, until we are able to fully inspect the break and confirm contractors for the repair we cannot be certain of the estimated timeframe and as a result we are implementing the necessary precautionary measures. We will keep you updated as additional information becomes available.
