FCSS information about Library:

As FCSS is focused on the delivery of preventative social services, FCSS funding cannot be used towards the cost of a library card or fees. The FCSS Regulations state the services provided under a program must not provide primarily for the recreational needs or leisure time pursuits of individuals.

This does not preclude FCSS funding from being used to support preventative programming delivered through a local library. This could include a range of activities, including the promotion of community capacity-building, developing interpersonal connections and building relationships, creating awareness of social needs, developing individuals' coping skills and a wide range of other programs and services falling within the scope of FCSS. FCSS funding can also be used to support libraries' planning of associated program planning, public awareness and education campaigns, information and referral services and volunteer training and development.
