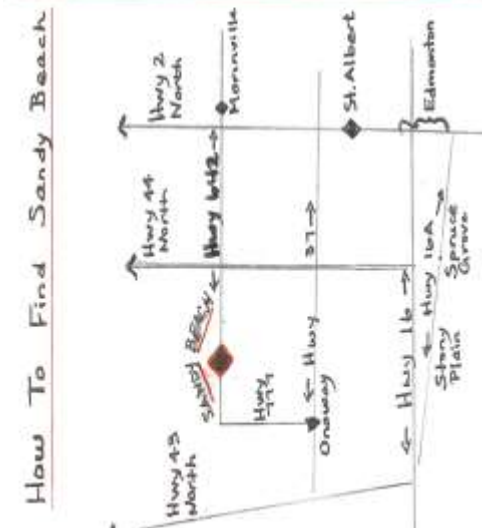
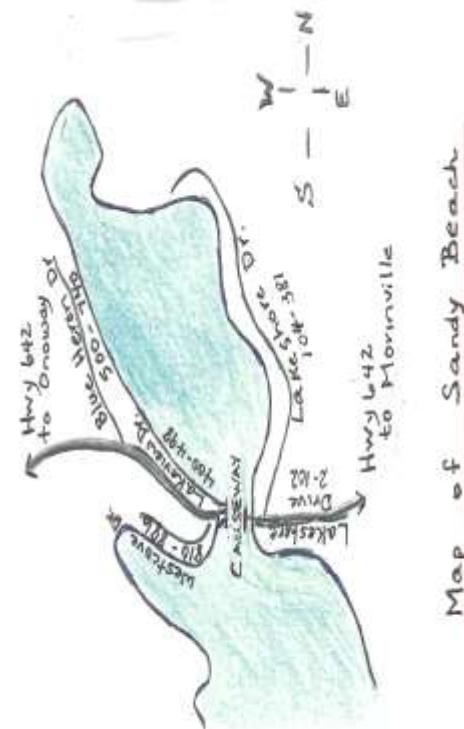

Our Little Piece of Paradise was incorporated under the Municipal Government Act over 60 years ago. The municipality currently has over 200 permanent residents but grows to over 500 in the summer months. We are one of the few Summer Villages in Alberta that are fortunate to have commercial properties. We have a General Store with gas pumps, propane services, and liquor outlet; a Burger Bar; and a Family Campground – just to name a few. We also have a Local pump truck, a Day Park and Public Beach with a Boat Launch, and a Kiddie Park. A Community Hall (with full facilities) is available to rent at a reasonable rate year round.

As with all other municipalities we have elections for a council – held every four years during the summer months. The three-person Council work together with Administrators not only to keep the Village running smoothly but to plan for it's future.
