

## Re: Lagoon Water Discharge Notification

A Lagoon Water discharge will be occurring from approx. August 15 - September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019. This letter is a time revised statement of your letter dated June 12-2019. Due to the persistent wet conditions Alberta Environment has allowed the time extension for the discharge. This discharge has been approved under the full authority of Alberta Environment.

There are no indications of any health risks to the public as a result of this approved discharge and the purpose of the discharge is to allow the rehabilitation of the existing lagoon system to ensure its operation for the future. The approved volume of discharge of 35,000 m3 will be discharged slowly over 45 days.



All residents are required to stay away from any wet areas or any ponded water in the discharge area. The area will be monitored and any persons in the area will be removed.
